
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established under GLO contract number 707, by Williard B. Blakeslee on June 15, 1901. Surveyor General's notes state: "Set a basalt stone $16 \times 8 \times 8$ ins. 10 ins. in the grad. for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/4 S on the W. face. Raised a mound of stone 10 lks. W. of the Cor. (pits Imp.) 3 ft. base and 24 ins. high.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found 16 x 8 x 8 inch stone clearly marked 1/4S with remains of mound of stone 5 ft. west.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the center of the above point, set 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked as shown. Set pipe 22" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap. Buried marked stone alongside of the pipe. No trees. Built 3 ft. high, 3 ft. base mound of stone 5 ft. west of the corner.
