S18 7/4----From which a burnt stump bears NO1°E., 24.4 ft. dist., no visible scribing. S19 24" stump. 54-3 was attached to stump. CS 1969

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E. I add: 10" pine bears N26°E., 39.0 ft. scribed 1/4 S18 BT. 10" Fir bears S42°E., 18.7 ft. scribed 1/4 S19 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-4s, and brass washers stamped PLS 1051. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' south and 54-2 on a steel fence post 5' East of the corner.
