History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established under G. L. O. contract number 707, by Williard B. Blakeslee on June 11, 1901. Surveyor General's notes state: "Falls on solid basalt rock in place, 24 X 12 X 12 ins., above grnd., for the corto secs. 15, 16, 21 & 22. I cut a cross (+) at exact corpt. and marked 3 notches on the S. & E. faces from which a pine 16 ins. in diam. brs. N75°W, 290 lks. dist. marked T7S R47E S16 BT and a pine 18 ins. in diam. brs. S25°30'E,

178 lks. dist. marked T7S R47E S21 BT. No other trees within limits, raised a mound of stone 3 ft. base, 23 ins. high, 10 lks. west of the corner."

Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of record stone. Area is on steep north slope and found no rock projecting even 6" above the ground. Found no trace of a BT in the SE quadrant. From temporary point, surveyed to computed point on line, from which a 26" pine bears \$63°W, 118.5 ft. Opened tree and found full scribe, including \$21. (Notes state SE bearing, but \$21 Scribe. This tree is not visible from record bearing and distance of the other record tree. Measuring to the southwest tree is almost horizontal and the other tree is on a 27° slope. From this point a 30" pine bears N65°W, 139.2 ft. horz. and 155.2 ft. slope. This is 210 lks. distance.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the center of the above point, set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized

pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 24" in the ground and

pipe and of stone around to cap. Built a mound of stone 3 * X 3',

5 ft. east of the corner.

A 16" pine bears N65°E, 41.9 ft. scribed T7S R47E S15 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3, 54-4 and brass washer stamped PLS 1051 on the BT. Placed 54-3 and 54-4 on the old BTs. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' north and placed 54-2 on a steel fence post 5' west of the corner.
