At the center of the above point, set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 24" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap. Buried marked stone alongside of the pipe.

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:

A 27" pine bears \$55°C., 186.6 ft. scribed 1/4\$21 BT. No other trees availiable. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-36, 54-46, and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on the BTs. Placed 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' north and raised a mound of stone 3 ft. base, 3 ft. high 5 ft. west of the corner.
