

From which by T-2 and EDM:

A 18" Pine bears S83%., 263.2 ft. scribed SW1/16 S19 BT. A 14" Pine bears N69°W., 318.1 ft. scribed SW1/16 S19 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around.

Placed 54-3s, 54-9s, and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on the BTs. Placed 54-2 on a steel fence post 5! south and placed 54-2 on a steel fence post 5! west of the corner.
