Description of corner evidence found:

found no trace of record stone or mound of stone. Corner falls $8.5~{\rm ft.}$ north of a "T" fence corner bearing south and east-west. Large rock jack at fence corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the center of surveyed point, set 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked as shown. Set pipe 21" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap. No trees.

Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' east and placed 54-2 on a steel fence post 5' west of the corner.

Built 2' x 3' mound of stone 5' west of the corner.
