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Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of record stone or mound. Surveyed point is near an old east-west fence. Corner falls on steep ME slope. Red tie tape on brush 25' ME of the corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the center of the surveyed point, set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 20" in the ground and

mound of stone around to cap,

No trees within limits. Built mound of stone 3' X 3' X 5' north of the corner.

Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' east and placed 54-2 on a steel fence post 5' west of the corner.
