

ORIGINAL G.L.O. DESCRIPTION:

Set basalt stone 16x12x10 ins 10 ins in the gro., for ¼ sec., cor. marked ¼ S on the W. face., raised a mound of stone 3 ft. base 24 ins. high, 10 lks W of the cor.,

EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found original stone 10"x9"x6" (appears to be broken) marked ¼ S. Found fragment of original stone alongside-no other stones nearby.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES SET:

Set 5/8" x 30" pin, 30" in the ground, with 2" aluminum cap marked as shown below. Placed marked stone (marks inverted) South and alongside pin in a 3' mound of stone.

FROM WHICH, I set the following reference points:

A $5/8" \times 30"$ iron pin bears N.39°23'E., 11.26 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears S.56*00'E., 8.50 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears S.41°33'W., 11.05 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears N.69°19'W., 13.48 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.

Used RTK GPS to measure RP's. Bearings to RP's are based on Geodetic North from a GPS observation taken at the W1/4 Cor. Section 35.
