

ORIGINAL G.L.O. DESCRIPTION:

Set Basalt stone 24x10x6 ins, 12 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs 25-26-35 & 36 marked with 1 notch on the S. and E. edges. raised mound of stone 3 ft. base 22 ins., high 10 lks., W. of the cor.

EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found mound of stone with remains of old fenceline running E—W 10' South of mound of stone. After a diligent search, we were unable to locate the original stone monument. I accept the center of the mound of stones as the best available evidence of the original GLO position for this corner.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES SET:

Set $5/8" \times 30"$ pin, 25" in the ground, with 2%" aluminum cap marked as shown below. Built 3' mound of stone around corner.

FROM WHICH, I set the following reference points:
A 5/8" x 24" iron pin bears N.07'26'E., 10.96 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.

A 5/8" x 24" iron pin bears S.37°13'E., 6.81 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.

A 5/8" x 24" iron pin bears S.51°34'W., 10.70 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.

A $5/8" \times 24"$ iron pin bears N.39°17'W., 9.39 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.

Used RTK GPS to measure RP's. Bearings to RP's are based on Geodetic North from a GPS observation taken at the W¼ Cor. Section 35.
