

NARRATIVE

This survey for George Parker was for the purpose of recovering the existing monumentation for tracts described in Deed 79-33-072 (T.L. 1617) and in Deed 79-33-073 (T.L. 1611).

The westerly line of the Northerly parcel (T.L. 1617) was extended southerly to intersect a Westerly extension of the Northerly line of the Southerly parcel (T.L. 1611) and monumented as shown.

T.L. 1611 description begins at O.S.H.D. Highway 86 Centerline Station 122+00.0 P.O.T. Highway monumentation for Station 115+00.0 P.I. and Station 90+04.61 was recovered and retraced for beginning point of this survey.

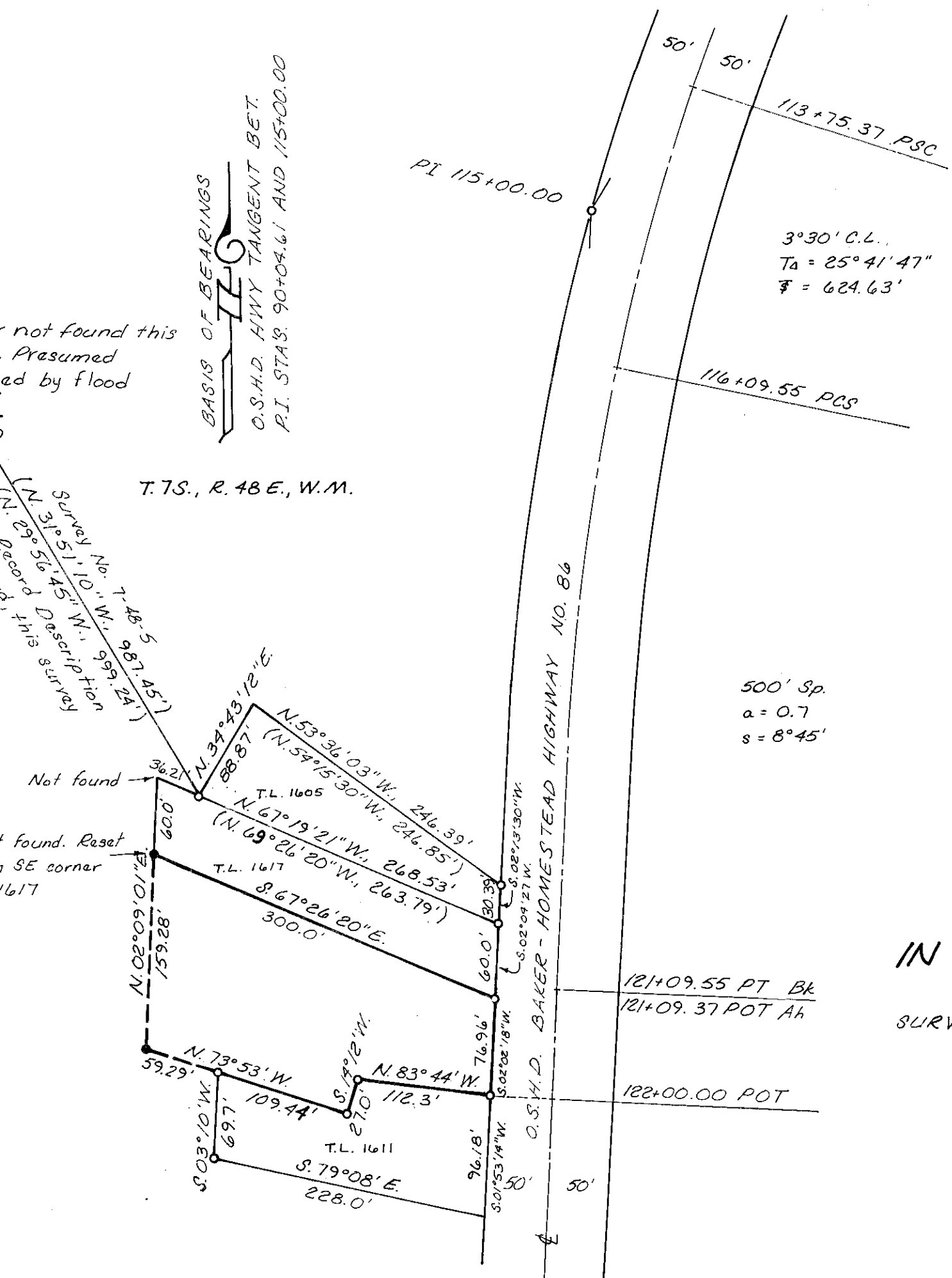
