
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The corner was originally established by Arthur Philbrick under Mineral Survey No. 477, during the survey of June and July 1902. The original notes state that at the corner a scribed black pine post 4' long by 4"sq. was set 12" in the ground from which:

A 6" black pine bears S37°26'E-21.46' scribed B.T.W.3-477.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a mound of earth with the remains of the rotted post at ground level from which:

An 11" dead standing lodgepole pine bears $S35\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E-21.6$ ' with healed blaze which when opened revealed scribing (original bearing tree). A 13" dead standing lodgepole pine bears N17°W-25.5' with partly healed blaze (original bearing tree). There is no original record of the bearing tree.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum casp 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Placed the remains of the post on the mound. From the monument:

A 10" engleman spruce bears $S84\frac{10}{2}$ E-15.9' scribed 3-W-477 BT. An 11" engleman spruce bears $S66\frac{10}{2}$ W-43.0' scribed 3-W-477 BT. New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 to each bearing tree and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. SEt steel fence post on National Forest Boundary NW and SW of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on August 9, 1985.
