
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:
The corner was originally established by Arthur Philbrick under Mineral Survey No. 477, during June and July 1902.
The original notes state that at the corner a scribed black pine post 4' long by 4" sq. was set 12" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth from which:
A 12" tamarack bears N88 20'W-44.60'.
A 3" tamarack bears S1 20'E-16.46'.
Both marked B.T.K.E.C.-477.



Description of corner evidence found: Found a mound of earth with a hole in the middle and rotted remains of post below ground. Also, found remains of original post lying beside mound. From the original post hole:

A 16" western larch bears N86½°W-44.9' with healed blaze (original bearing tree). A 5" dead, standing western larch bears  $S1\frac{1}{2}$ E-16.5' with visible scribing on partly healed blaze (original bearing tree).

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner:

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 22" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Placed remains of original post on the mound. From the monument:

A 7" alpine fir bears  $S1\frac{1}{2}^{O}W-32.5$ ' scribed EEC-K-477 BT. New bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9 to each bearing tree and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence post on claim line near corner and attached sign 54-9.

Used steel tape and staff compass with  $20^{\circ}\mathrm{E}$  declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on July 25, 1985.
