
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Arthur Philbrick under Mineral Survey No. 477, during June and July 1902. The original notes state that at the corner a scribed black pine post 4' long by 4" sq. was set 12" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone from which:
A 6" black pine bears N37°E-8.1'.
An 8" black pine bears N73°W-8.95'.
Both marked B.T.R.3-477.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found the rotted remains of the post at ground level from which:

A very rotten up-rooted lodgepole pine bears N37°E-8.1' with axe marks visible on part of blaze (original bearing tree). A very rotten down lodgepole pine bears N73°W-9' with fragmentary scribing (original bearing tree).

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 20" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone from which:

An 8" white fir bears N58 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E-20.9' scribed 3-R-477 BT. A 9" white fir bears N36°W-25.3' scribed 3-R-477 BT. New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9 to each bearing tree and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary NW and NE of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Used steel tape and staff compass with $20^{\circ}\,\mathrm{E}$ declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

Cap is marked:
MS 477

This corner was remonumented on August 28, 1985.
