B. MONUMENT FOUND:

I found a 2.5" dia. brass cap on a 1.0" dia. iron pipe 14" exposed in mine tailings. The pipe was leaning north with rotted wood post remnants along U S GENERAL LAND OFFICE SURVEY the SW side to base. Cap marked: PENALTY \$250 FOR REMOVAL

ACCESSORIES FOUND:

11937 Dead and down rotted remains of fir with visible scribing on tailings pile 13" Spruce bears S73-30E, 10.1 ft. partially healed blaze and scribing

Painted a 6" wide red band around each BT

Placed brass washer marked "PLS 2060" at base of each BT blaze

Placed metal sign with bearing and distance information on each BT (54-3)

Placed metal ATTENTION sign on each BT (54-4)

Placed 6 ft. steel fence post at corner with metal PROPERTY BOUNDARY sign and metal ATTENTION sign (54-2 and 54-4) attached

I measured to the centerline of each bearing tree using tape and hand

compass with declination set at 20 degrees east.
