
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by C.M.Foster under Mineral Survey No.129 (Later renumbered MS 77) and dated July 16,1885.

Original notes state:

A post marked S.A.H.No.2-129.

Description of corner evidence found:

The corner area has burnt since corner established in 1885, somestraces of charcoal were found in corner area.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

The corner position was re-established by using the tie from Casaubon Cor.1, deflecting record angle from Casaubon line 2-1, and measuring record distance from Casaubon Cor.1. At position established from Casaubon Cor.l...

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 28" in ground and surrounded with mound of earth & stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A 11" western larch brs S15 E, 25.3' scribed 2-M-77 BT. A 13" lodgepole pine brs N80 $\frac{1}{2}$ E, 50.7' scribed 2-M-77 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze & 6" red band around each BT. Set steel fence post on National Forest Boundary SW of corner & attached sign 54-2 & 54-9.

Compass declination $18^{\rm O}$ East.
