
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position determined by survey...

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 28" in ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A 7" western larch brs  $508^{\circ}W$ , 5.3' scribed INTEXHM-77/C-505 BT. A 10" western larch brs  $875\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ , 28.0' scribed INTEX-M-77/C-505 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9 to each BT & painted face of blaze & 6" red band around each BT. Set steel fence post on National Forest Boundary NE of corner with sign 54-2 & 54-9 attached.

Compass declination 180 East.
