CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:


This corner was originally established by Arthur Philbrick under Mineral Survey No. 481, the position of this corner was Amended in May, 1904, by Arthur B.Browne under Amended Mineral Survey No. 481.

Browne's original notes state:

A post 6 in.sq. 4 ft. long, set 1 ft. in the ground with a mound of earth and stone, scribed RF. 1-481.

A red fir tree 6 in. in diameter blazed and scribed B.T.R.F. 1-481, bears S18^o8'E, 18.3 ft.

A red fir tree 35 in. in diameter blazed and scribed B.T.R.F. 1-481, bears N53 $^{\circ}$ 54'W, 42.36 ft.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found rotted post remains below ground level, from which, A 42" sawn douglas fir stump brs N35 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 43.9'(Record: 53°54'-the 3 & 5 are switched) with bottom of blaze and catface visible.(Original BT) A 23" white fir brs S18 $\frac{1}{4}$ °E, 18.8' with healed blaze. (Original BT)

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position of found post remains...

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 26" in ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A 29" ponderosa pine brs S54 $\frac{10}{4}$ W, 53.0' scribed 1-RF AMD-481 BT. A 21" ponderosa pine brs S80 $\frac{1}{2}$ W, 99.8' scribed 1-RF AMD-481 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9 to each BT & painted face of blaze & 6" red band around each BT. Set steel fence post on National Forest Boundary NE of corner with sign 54-2 & 54-9 attached.

Compass declination $18^{\rm O}$ East.
