A pine 22 inch diam bears S 252° W. 332 lks. dist. with healed blaze.

No trace of original section 13 BT.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Improved surrounding rock mound around corner monument and set a 6 foot steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-9 attached.

New bearing tree:

A pine 12 inches diam bears N. 05° W., 16.0 ft. dist. marked T 8 S R 36 E S 13 BT and has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.

To each bearing tree attached a sign 54-3 above BT blaze and below a 6 inch band of red paint and a sign 54-9 attached to opposite side of tree from BT blaze.
