CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The corner was originally established by Arthur Philbrick under Mineral Survey No. 477, during June and July 1902. The original notes state that at the corner a scribed tamarack post 4' long by 4" sq. was set 12" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth from which:

A 20" tamarack bears N52°E-11.45'.

A 6" black pine bears S40°50'-7.92'.

Both marked B.T.W. 4-R. 7-477.

Description of corner evidence found:
Found an earth mound with remains of post at ground level and the original wood post lying beside the mound. From the post hole:
A 24" western larch bears N52 E-12.2' with healed blaze (original bearing tree).
A 7" dead and down lodgepole pine bears S40 3/4 W-7.9' with visible scribing on open blaze (original bearing tree).

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 20" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Placed original wood post on mound. From the monument:

A 9" white fir bears S65½°E-20.5' scribed 4-W-7-R-477 BT.

New bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze.

Attached signs 54-9 and 54-3 to each bearing tree and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence post on claim line near corner and attached sign 54-9.

Cap is marked:

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on July 25, 1985.
