
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

The corner was originally established by Arthur Philbrick under Mineral Survey No. 477, during June and July 1902. The original notes state that at the corner a scribed black pine post 4' long and 4" sq. was set 12" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth from which: A 6" spruce bears S84°30'E-3.2'. A 12" black pine bears N3°52'E-25.6'. Both marked B.T.W. 5-R. 6-477.

Description of corner evidence found:
Found the original post hole below ground level. Also, found remains of post above ground. From the original post hole:

An 11" dead spruce bears S84½°E-3.5' with scribing visible on partly healed blaze (original bearing tree). A 12" dead lodgepole pine bears N4°E-25.9' with scribing visible on open blaze (original bearing tree).

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 22" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Placed remains of wood post on the mound. From the monument:

A 14" Engleman spruce bears N56½ W-25.5' scribed 5-W-6-R-477 BT. An 18" Engleman spruce bears N85½ E-16.4' scribed 5-W-6-R-477 BT. Each new bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9 to each bearing tree and painted the face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence post on claim line near corner and attached sign 54-9.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on July 25, 1985.
