
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Arthur Philbrick under Mineral Survey No. 477, during June and July 1902. The original notes state that at the corner a scribed tamarack post 4' long by 4" sq. was set 12" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone from which: A 48" tamarack bears S6°15'E-20.15'. A 20" black pine bears N25°45'E-17.33'. Both marked B.T.M.3-477.



Description of corner evidence found: A mound of earth and stone with rotted remains of the post at ground level from which:

A 45" western larch bears $S6\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}E-21.5$! with scribing visible on partly healed blaze (original bearing tree). An 18" dead lodgepole pine bears N2 $7\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E-18.2$! with scribing visible on partly healed blaze (original bearing tree).

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 15" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stones from which:

A 6" alpine fir bears S55½°W-14.3' scribed 3-M-477 BT.

New bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze.

Attached signs 54-3 and 54-9 to each bearing tree and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary SE and SW of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Cap is marked:

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20° E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on August 29, 1985.
