
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Arthur Philbrick under Mineral Survey No. 477, during June and July 1902. The original notes state that at the corner a scribed tamarack post 4' long by 4" sq. was set 12" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone from which: A 14" red fir bears S59 20'W-39.51'. A 10" black pine bears N54 12'E-9.78'. Both marked B.T.M.W.C.-477.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 12" dead, lodgepole pine bears N54 $\frac{10}{4}$ E-9.8' to face of blaze and 10.2' to center line with visible scribing on partly healed blaze (original bearing tree). A 22" down white fir bears S60 $^{\circ}$ W-40' $^{\pm}$ with scribing visible on partly healed blaze (original bearing tree).

Corner position was re-established by record bearing and distance from lodgepole pine bearing tree measuring to face of blaze.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " by 30" aluminum pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone from which:

A 7" lodgepole pine bears N464°W-25.3' scribed WEC-M-477 BT.

A 9" alpine fir bears N78½°W-35.6' scribed WEC-M-477 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-9 and 54-3 to each bearing tree and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence posts on National Forest Boundary NE and SW of corner and attached sign 54-9 to one post and sign 54-2 to both posts.

Cap is marked:

Used steel tape and staff compass with 20°E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

This corner was remonumented on August 29, 1985.
