A red fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N83-31E, 6.44 ft., and a tamarack, 30 ins. diam., bears S43-10W, 24.44 ft., each blazed and scribed

Description of corner evidence found:

B. MONUMENT FOUND:

I found a 4"x3"x4" rotted powdery remains of wood post 14" in the ground on large stone.

ACCESSORIES FOUND:

21" dia. Grand Fir bears NB7E, 7.0 ft. with healed blaze. (did not open) Western Larch sawn stump bears \$47W, 25.4 ft. with no visible marks.

Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

CORNER WORK DONE ON 6/19/90

At the position of the pointed post remnant, set a 2.5" dia. by 30" long C. aluminum pipe with a 2.5" dia. aluminum cap. The pipe is set 18" in the ground with a mound of stone to 3" of the top. The cap is marked:

23" dia. Grand Fir bears N9W, 20.7 ft.; scribed 1 MS 485 GH BT

Painted the blaze red on each BT Painted a 6" wide red band around each BT Placed brass washer marked "PLS 2060" at base of each BT blaze Placed metal sign with bearing and distance information on each BT (54-3) Placed metal ATTENTION sign on each BT (54-4)Placed 6 ft. metal guard post at corner with metal PROPERTY BOUNDARY sign

and metal ATTENTION sign (54-2 and 54-4)

I measured to the centerline of each bearing tree using tape and hand compass with declination set at 20 degrees east.
