CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION


History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by John Hagel under Mineral Survey No.427 and surveyed under instructions dated July 8, 1901.

Original notes state:

Set a white fir post 4 ins.square, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft.long, 18 ins in the ground, with a mound of rocks around it, scribed Alta Q.Cl.,C.4-427.

A white fir tree 5 ins.diam.bears $N.28^{\circ}W$, 20.8 ft. A white fir tree 8 ins.diam.bears $S65^{\circ}W$, 35.6 ft.: both blazed and scribed Alta Q.Cl., C.4-427-B.T.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of original post.

A 14" white fir brs N29 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 20.8' to blaze face & 20.9' to center with previously opened but not healed blaze.(Original BT) A 20" white fir brs S63 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 35.6' to blaze face & 35.9' to center with healed blaze.(Original BT)

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Re-established corner by intersecting record distances, measuring from original blaze face, from which...

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 28" in ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing tree established: A 14" western larch brs S27 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 51.2' scribed 4-A-427 BT. Other accessory: "XBO" chiseled in the East face of a 8'x6'x3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' out of ground granite rock, brs S80 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 42.4'.

New bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around BT. Measured to "X" on the bearing object markings. Painted "XBO" marking on bearing object red. Placed sign 54-3 & 54-9 on BT and bearing object. Set steel fence post NE of corner on National Forest Boundary and attached sign 54-2 7 54-9.

Compass declination 180 East.

I hereby certify that the above corner was properly re-established by me to U.S.F.S. standards on September 15, 1992.
