
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Charles M.Foster under Mineral Survey No.505, surveyed under instructions dated April 5, 1904.

Original notes state:

A pine post, 4 ft long, 4 ins square set 18 ins in the ground, surrounded with a mound of earth, scribed C-2-505.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found rotted post remains in mound of stone after determining search area by survey.

Description of monument and accessories i established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At position of found post remains...

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 28" in ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established: A 11" western larch brs S75 $^{\circ}$ W, 47.6' scribed 2-C-505 BT. A 9" lodgepole pine brs S66 $^{\frac{1}{2}}$ E, 21.3' scribed 2-C-505 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9 to each BT & painted face of blaze & 6" red band around each BT. Set steel fence post on National Forest Boundary SW of corner with sign 54-2 & 54-9 attached.

Compass declination $18^{\rm O}$ East.

I hereby certify that the above corner was properly remonumented by me to U.S.F.S. standards on September 16, 1992.
