

Found rotted remains of post below level, from which:

A 32" white fir brs $S57^{\circ}E$, 11.9' with healed blaze.

(Original BT) A 10" down lodgepole pine brs S55 $3/4^{\circ}$ W, $18.8'^{\pm}$ to root hole with scribes visible on partially healed blaze.(Original BT)

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At position of found post remains...

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap 28" in ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing tree established: A 17" western larch brs $S41\frac{1}{2}^{0}W$, 24.1' scribed 6-C-505 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9 to each BT & painted face of blaze & 6" red band around each BT. Set steel fence post on National Forest Boundary SW of corner with sign 54-2 & 54-9 attached.

Compass declination 180 East.
