

**EVIDENCE FOUND:** Found Mitchell's unrecorded monument, which is a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " galvanized iron pipe with a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap, marked as shown, projecting 3" above ground in a 2 ft. diameter mound of stone, with a steel fence post with USFS 54-9 sign attached, set NE and alongside the mound. From which,

- ► A Douglas-fir, 19" dbh, bears N.01°E., 14.42 ft. with fully-healed single blaze (Mitchell BT)
- ► A white fir, 16" dbh, bears S.84°W., 33.0 ft. with fully-healed single blaze (Mitchell BT)

# **DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:**

I accept Mitchell's brass cap monument as a faithful and accurate perpetuation of the original corner, being harmoniously related to other known corners of Mineral Survey No. 593.

I attached new USFS 54-3 and 54-9 signs to the bearing trees. Distances measured with a steel tape to a Mag Spike driven in the side-center-right at the root crown of each tree, with an attached 1 ½" aluminum washer stamped PLS 69454. Used RTK GPS to measure bearings. Bearings are geodetic, based on GPS observation taken at the corner. See associated Map of Survey dated August 20, 2025 for survey-related information.
