

ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION: Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked (diagram shown) from which

A tamarack, 7 ins. dia., bears S. 26° E., 25 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 33 BT. A white fir, 7 ins. dia., bears N. $10\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 45 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 32 BT.

HANLEY'S DESCRIPTION:

A tamarack 22 ins diam bears S26°E, 25 lks dist with fully healed blaze. A fir 22 ins diam bears N10 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W, 45 lks dist with fully healed blaze.

At corner position established from above noted original accessories, found a brass cap monument in concrete encasement and marked as shown in corner diagram.

Improved surrounding rock mound around recovered corner monument and set a 6 foot steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-9 attached.

No new bearing trees established.

EVIDENCE FOUND: Found $1\frac{1}{2}$ " galvanized iron pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap, marked as shown below, projecting 5" above ground, with a steel fence post with attached USFS 54-9 sign set northwesterly, 3 ft. from the found monument.

From which:

A western larch, 27" dbh, bears S.26°E., 16.5 ft., in good condition.


A fir, 28" dbh, bears N.10 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 29.7 ft., in good condition.

Note: there were piles of dirt pushed up against the front of both trees, covering the blaze locations.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:
