
RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

INTERSECTION OF SOUTHEASTERLY LINE OF HYDRAULIC PLACER CLAIM, MS 410, WITH SOUTH LINE SECTION 32, T. 8 S., R. 37 E., W.M.

ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION: Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 30 ins long 25 ins in ground with 5 ins proj. out of ground with surrounding rock mound and 6 ft steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached.

Aluminum cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established:

A fir 6 ins dia bears S35½°W 46.0 ft dist.

A fir 7 ins dia bears N47°E 34.6 ft dist, both trees marked 1 2 HPC 410/S 32 BT.

EVIDENCE FOUND: Found $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, marked as shown below, projecting 6" above ground, in a 2 ft. diameter mound of stone, with a steel fence post with attached USFS signs 54-2 and 54-9 set West, 4 ft. from monument.

From which,

- ► A white fir, dead and down, bears N.47°E., 34.6 ft.
- \blacktriangleright A white fir, 14" dbh, bears S.35 ½°W., 46.0 ft., in good condition with healed single blaze.


DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:

I accept the position of the found monument for the corner.

From which, I SCRIBE A NEW BEARING TREE:

► A white fir, 15" dbh, bears S.75°E., 45.14 ft. marked X in upper blaze, and BT in lower blaze.

CORNER MONUMENT MARKED:



Rebuilt the rock mound, 3 ft. diameter to top. Painted a 6 inch red band around each bearing tree, painted the blazes red, and attached USFS 54-3 and 54-9 signs. Used a magnetic compass with 14° East declination to measure bearings to BT's. Used an EDM device to measure distance to new bearing tree, measuring to a 60d nail driven in the side-center-right at the root crown of the tree, with an attached $1\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum washer stamped PLS 69454.
