

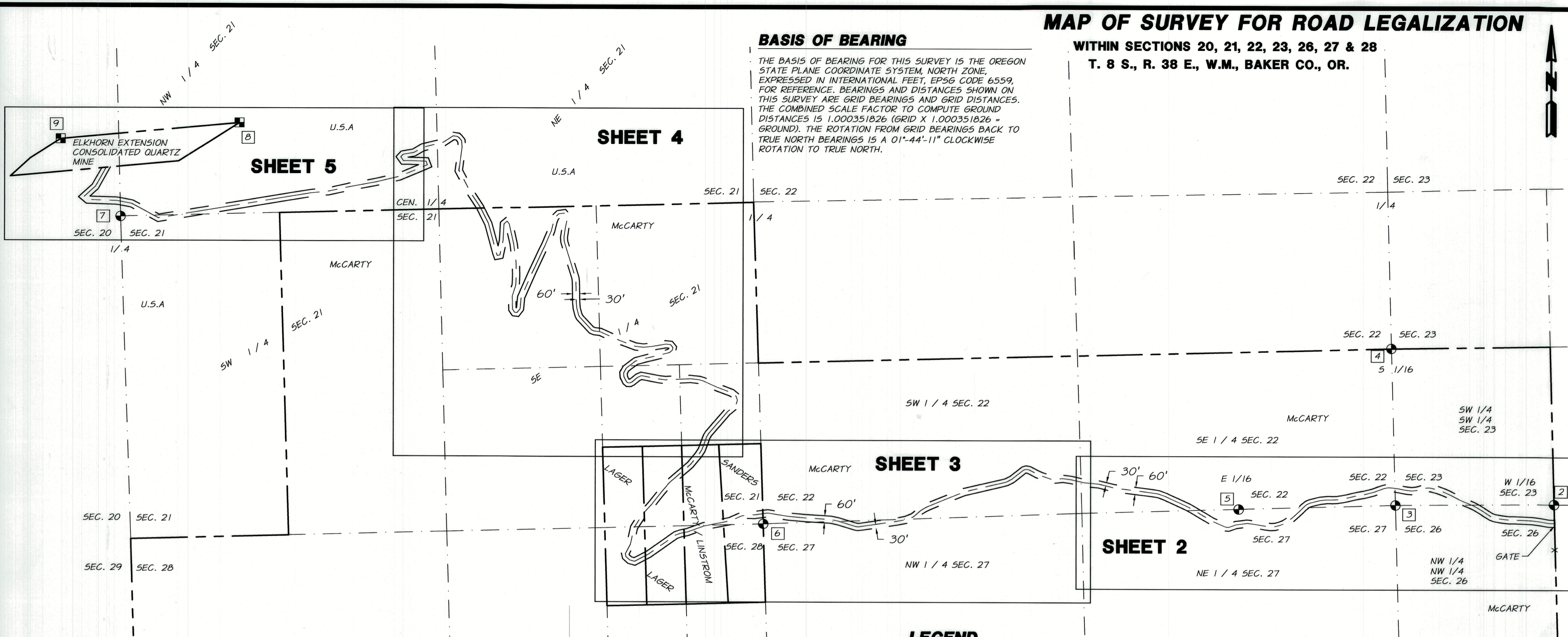
# MAP OF SURVEY FOR ROAD LEGALIZATION

## BASIS OF BEARING

THE BASIS OF BEARING FOR THIS SURVEY IS THE OREGON STATE PLANE COORDINATE SYSTEM, NORTH ZONE, EXPRESSED IN INTERNATIONAL FEET, EPSG CODE 6559, FOR REFERENCE. BEARINGS AND DISTANCES SHOWN ON THIS SURVEY ARE GRID BEARINGS AND GRID DISTANCES. THE COMBINED SCALE FACTOR TO COMPUTE GROUND DISTANCES IS 1.000351826 (GRID X 1.000351826 = GROUND). THE ROTATION FROM GRID BEARINGS BACK TO TRUE NORTH BEARINGS IS A 01°-44'-11" CLOCKWISE ROTATION TO TRUE NORTH.



## SURVEY NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF THE BAKER COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF LEGALIZING THE ROAD TO THE ELKHORN EXTENSION CONSOLIDATED QUARTZ MINE, LOCALLY KNOWN AS THE BAISLEY ELKHORN MINE. THE ROAD WAS ORIGINALLY ESTABLISHED BY THE ROAD VIEWERS PROCESS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORS 268.161. THE ROAD VIEWERS REPORT, INCLUDING THE ROAD VIEWERS NOTES OF THE SURVEY OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD, WERE FILED JULY 8, 1891 IN BAKER COUNTY RECORDS BY C.M. FOSTER, BAKER COUNTY SURVEYOR. A PLAT OF THE SURVEY OF THE ROAD WAS ALSO COMPLETED BY C.M. FOSTER AND FILED MAY 29, 1891 IN BAKER COUNTY RECORDS. BASED ON THE FILED ROAD VIEWERS REPORT AND THE FILED PLAT, THE ROAD WAS ORDERED OPENED AND ESTABLISHED BY BAKER COUNTY JUDGE P. CAMPBELL IN THE BAKER COUNTY COURT JOURNAL DATED JULY 10, 1891. THE ROAD WAS ORDERED TO BE ANNEXED TO BAKER COUNTY ROAD DISTRICT NUMBER 3.

IN THE ROAD VIEWERS REPORT THE ROAD COMMENCES "AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST ONE QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST ONE-QUARTER OF SECTION 29 IN TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH OF RANGE 39 EAST WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN IN BAKER COUNTY OREGON. THENCE BY THE WAY OF ROBBINS QUARTZ MILL TO THE ELKHORN QUARTZ MINE BELONGING TO THE ELKHORN MINING COMPANY." NO WIDTH IS STATED IN THE 1891 BAKER COUNTY COURT JOURNAL ORDER OPENING THE ROAD. OREGON LAWS 1889, PAGE 87, SECTION 2 PRESCRIBE THE STANDARD WIDTH OF A COUNTY ROAD AS BEING 60 FEET, SUBJECT TO, UPON THE PRAYER OF THE PETITIONERS, A MAXIMUM WIDTH OF 80 FEET AND A MINIMUM WIDTH OF 40'.

THE PORTION OF THE ROAD BEING LEGALIZED AS SHOWN ON THIS SURVEY IS LOCATED WITHIN IN SECTIONS 20, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27 AND 28 OF TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH RANGE 38 EAST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN. THE PHYSICAL CENTERLINE OF THE EXISTING ROAD WAS SURVEYED, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ROAD LEGALIZATION PROCEEDINGS DEFINED IN ORS 368.201. TRIMBLE R12 DUAL FREQUENCY RECEIVERS IN REAL TIME KINEMATIC MODE WERE USED TO SURVEY THE ROAD AND THE PUBLIC LAND CORNERS IN THE AREA OF THE ROAD LEGALIZATION, AS SHOWN. THE TERMINUS OF THE ROAD AT THE BAISLEY ELKHORN MINE WAS COMPUTED AND RETRACED BASED ON THE GLO RECORDS OF MINERAL SURVEY NUMBER 208 (MS 208). MS 208 CONSISTS OF A NUMBER OF QUARTZ CLAIMS OF THE ELKHORN MINING COMPANY REFERRED TO ON THE PLAT AS THE ELKHORN EXTENSION CONSOLIDATED QUARTZ MINE. (THE BAISLEY ELKHORN MINE). THE MINE WAS PATENTED ON SEPTEMBER 21, 1892. A MOUND OF STONE, WITH REMNANTS OF A PVC PIPE IN THE MOUND, WERE FOUND AND HELD TO ESTABLISH THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE MINE. A TOPOGRAPHIC CALL FROM THE GLO SURVEY OF TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M., COMPLETED UNDER CONTRACT NUMBER 635, BY MANIUS BUCHANAN, U.S. DEPUTY SURVEYOR, WHICH PLAT WAS APPROVED NOVEMBER 28, 1896, FROM THE WEST SECTION LINE OF SAID SECTION 21 TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE "BAISLEY ELKHORN MILL SITE" WAS USED TO ESTABLISH THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE MINE. OTHER EVIDENCE OF MINE TAILINGS, OLD BUILDING REMNANTS AND COLLAPSED MINING TUNNEL REMAINS WERE FOUND WITHIN THE MINE SITE.

MONUMENTS HAVE BEEN SET ALONG THE CENTERLINE OF THE EXISTING ROAD, AS SHOWN. IT WAS CONSIDERED IMPRACTICAL TO MONUMENT ALL THE POINTS OF INTERSECTION MARKING THE TANGENTS THAT DEFINE THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD, SO MONUMENTS HAVE BEEN SET AT AN APPROXIMATE INTERVAL OF 1000 FEET, AS SHOWN. THE BASIS OF BEARING FOR THIS ROAD LEGALIZATION SURVEY IS THE OREGON STATE PLANE COORDINATE SYSTEM, NORTH ZONE, EXPRESSED IN INTERNATIONAL FEET, EPSG CODE 6559 FOR REFERENCE. BEARINGS ARE GRID BEARINGS AND DISTANCES ARE GRID DISTANCES. SEE THE BASIS OF BEARING NOTE FOR THE ROTATION TO TRUE NORTH BEARINGS AND THE COMBINED SCALE FACTOR TO REDUCE DISTANCES TO GROUND DISTANCES.

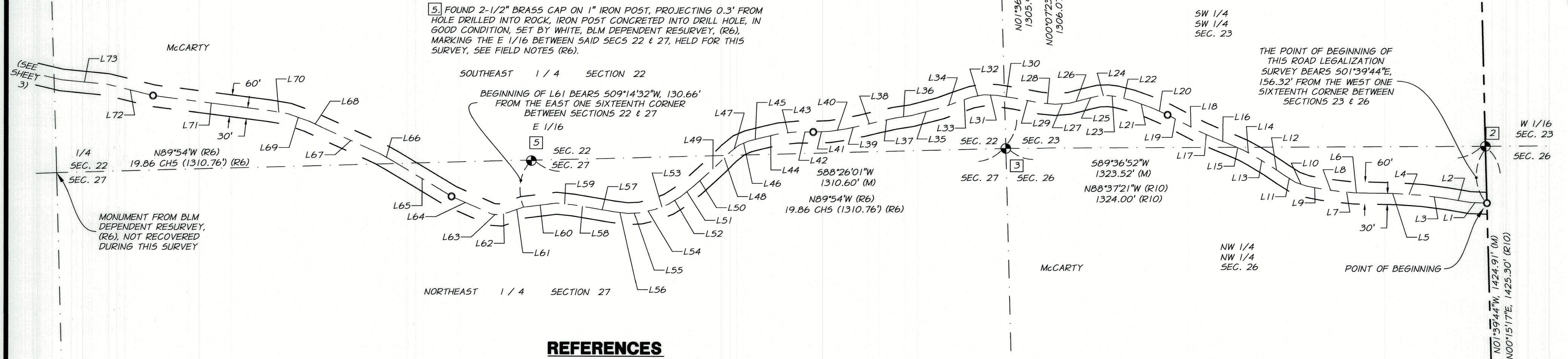

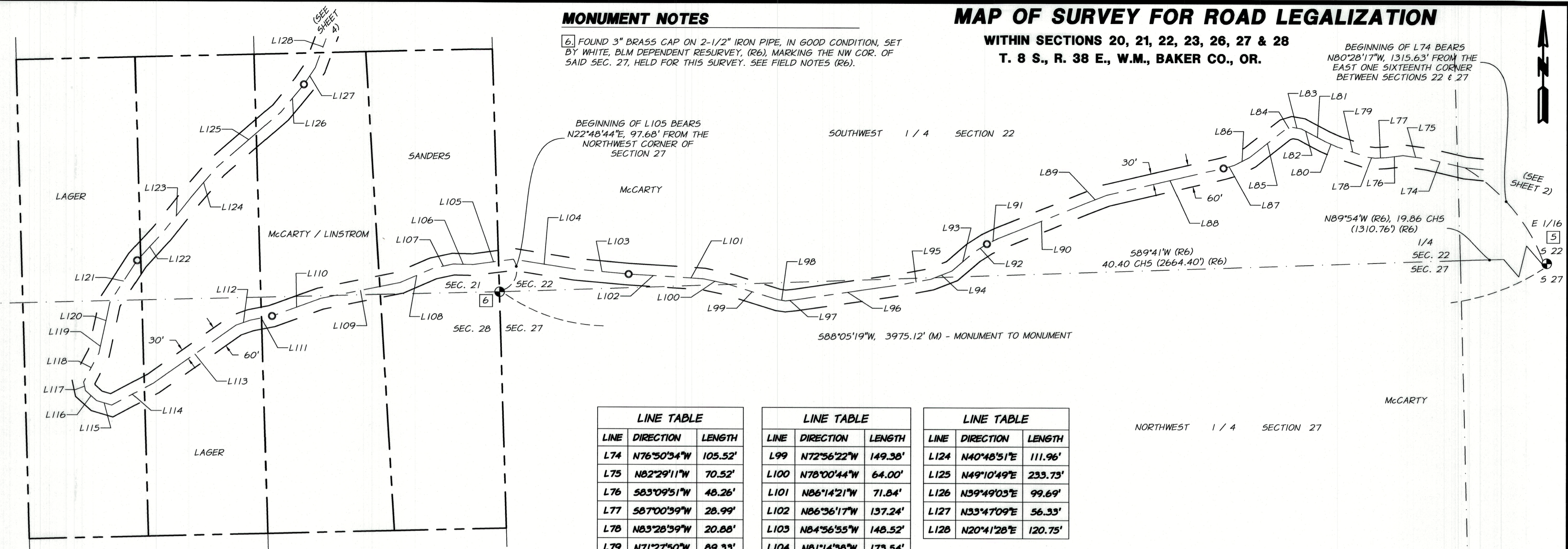

# MAP OF SURVEY FOR ROAD LEGALIZATION

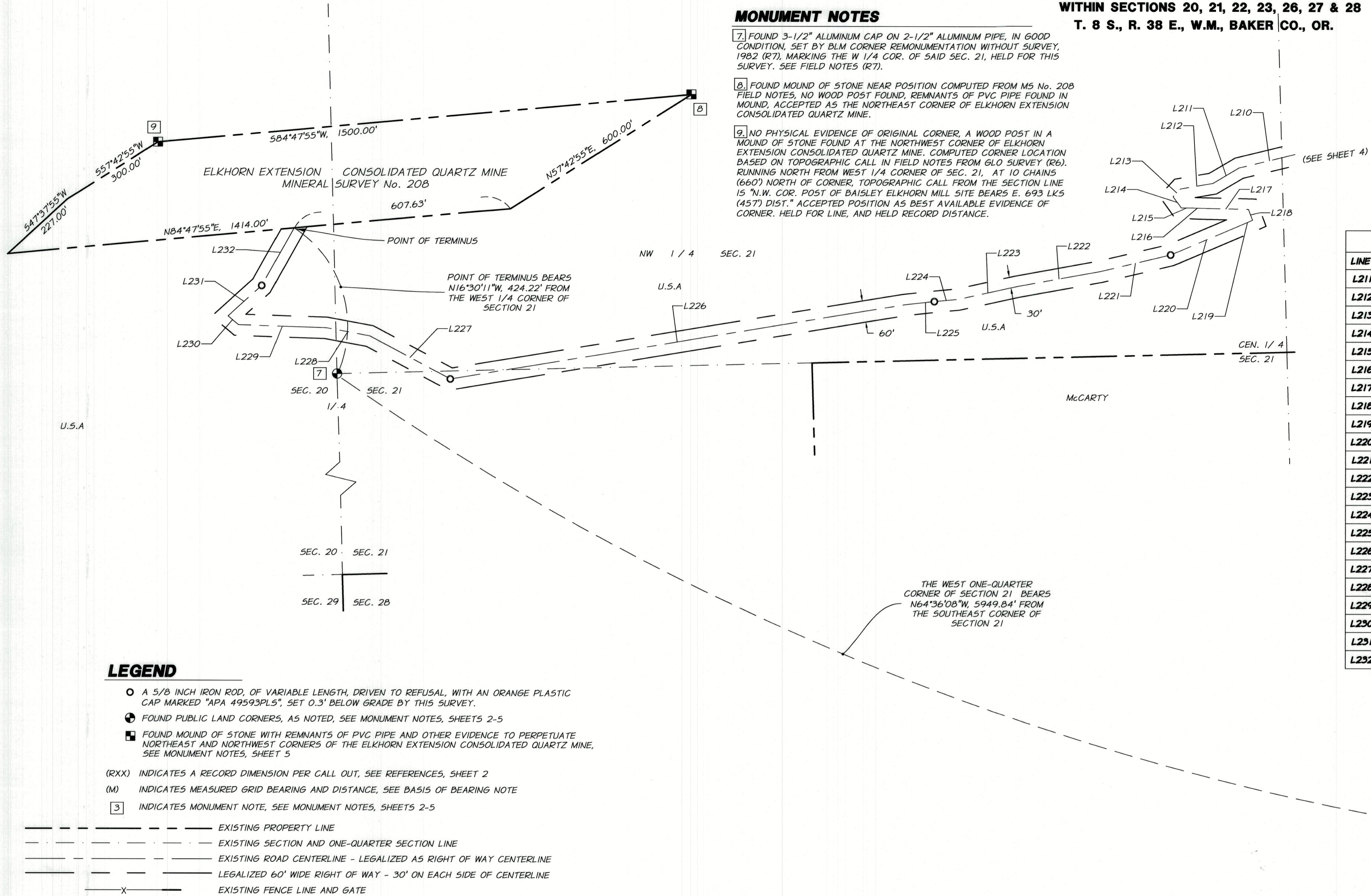
