

DITCH EASEMENT

Easement is conveyed to those with a legal water right for irrigation beyond the boundary of said parcel fed by any existing improved ditch. To those persons, as granted a perpetual, non-exclusive easement for it and its laterals, feeders and sub-ditches, headgates and other appurtenances to operate, use, maintain, etc. restore and repair the existing ditch in the same manner as same presently exists upon, over and across the property as shown on the annexed minor partition plat. The total width shall equal the bank to bank ditch width, plus 15 feet beyond the bank on each side of the ditch. There is no evidence or affirmation as to any existing ditch and/or ditch right of way upon, across or over these premises.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE
