

ELKHORN PRELIMINARY TITLE REPORT ORDER NO. 18203

NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS MAP OF SURVEY IS TO SHOW PINS THAT WERE SET FOR A PROPOSED LAND PARTITION BY FRED AND LINDA PALMER. THE RECORDING OF THE LAND PARTITION PLAT HAS BEEN DELAYED. THEREFOR, I AM FILING THIS MAP OF SURVEY TO DOCUMENT THE IRON PINS THAT I SET DURING THE SURVEY FOR THE LAND PARTITION.

A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE AVAILABLE RECORDS PERTAINING TO THIS SURVEY. WE MADE FIELD MEASUREMENTS TO LOCATE APPURTENANT MONUMENTS SHOWN ON RECORD MAP OF SURVEY NO.'S 8-39-14 AND 8-39-83 AND LAND PARTITION PLAT NO.'S 1995-015, 1997-005 AND 1997-018. WE FOUND THE MOST WESTERLY MONUMENT FROM LP 1995-015 0.20 FT. SOUTH OF THE RECORD POSITION. I DO NOT ACCEPT THIS MONUMENT. WE ALSO SEARCHED FOR, BUT DID NOT FIND THE PIN AT THE SE CORNER OF PARCEL 5 FROM LAND PARTITION PLAT NO. 1995-015.

WE FOUND TWO UNRECORDED 5/8" IRON PINS NEAR THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF THIS TRACT. THESE PINS APPEAR TO HAVE BEEN SET BY A FENCE BUILDER. I ACCEPT ALL OTHER APPURTENANT FOUND MONUMENTS, AS SHOWN HEREON.

NEW MONUMENTS WERE SET AT POSITIONS APPROVED BY THE PALMERS IN PREPARATION FOR THE LAND PARTITION, AND ACCORDING TO THE EVIDENCE FOUND, AS SHOWN HEREON.
