


**EVIDENCE FOUND:** I searched for but did not find the spike.

## **DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:**

At the midpoint between found accepted monuments, I set a 5/8"x24" iron pin with attached 2" aluminum cap 27" in the ground. Cap is marked as shown below.

## From which, I UTILIZED THE FOLLOWING MONUMENTS AS REFERENCE POINTS:

- ► A 5/8" iron pin with no cap, set during the survey for Summerfield West Subdivision, bears S.00°04'36"W., 30.00 ft.
- ► A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears S.75°21'35"W., 120.20 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.



Used RTK GPS to measure the reference points. Bearings are based on associated Land Partition dated September 23, 2019.
