
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was set by J.H. Stone, Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 235, dated July 6, 1875.

The original notes state:
Set Post 4 feet long, 4 in. in dia. 1 foot in ground and raised mound and trench as per instructions for ½ Sec. Cor.



## Description of corner evidence found:

An extensive search was made for the original post. No original corner evidence found.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of the corner:

The corner was reestablished at the position established by the Hubbs Dam Survey. The Hubbs Dam Survey established this corner at a fence intersection (fences ran East, West, and North from the intersection). A drilled nail was set at that position. Due to property line adjustments in the area the fence intersection no longer exists, only the East-West running fence remains. No trace of the drilled nail could be found. Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter brass cap on a 1" x 30" galvanized pipe at the position established by the said Hubbs Dam Survey. The cap is marked as shown in the corner diagram.

Corner monument references:

From the corner monument:

A  $5/8" \times 30"$  rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "HANLEY ENGR. PLS 1817" set approximately 8" below ground, bears N. 47° 55' 02" E., 10.39'.

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "HANLEY ENGR. PLS 1817" set approximately 8" below ground, bears S. 67° 44' 13" E., 12.58'.

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "HANLEY ENGR. PLS 1817" set approximately 8" below ground, bears S. 62° 20' 46" W., 11.80'.

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "HANLEY ENGR. PLS 1817" set approximately 8" below ground, bears N. 43° 41' 50" W., 11.95'.

Reference survey and basis of bearing: Baker County Survey No. 8-42-15.
