


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by W. B. Barr under contract dated September 10, 1880.

Surveyor's General record states:

Marked lava rock 10 ins. x 10 ins. x 10 ins. and dug pits.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found 11 ins. x 10 ins. x 9 ins. lava rock.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Set a 2½ inch brass cap on a 1 inch iron pipe, 30 inches long, 24 inches in the ground, and buried stone 4 ft. West and set a steel fence post 2 ft. East.
