Found 14"x10"x8" stone marked "%" in fence jack. This is probably the stone set by Hoffman in 1914 where he found an unmarked stone in a mound mound. Stone marked "%" acceepted as best evidence of original corner location.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " aluminum cap 25" in ground in small mound of stone, marked;
Buried marked stone alongside pipe,
Placed broken green glass and a crushed aluminum cap in

base of hole as memorials, No stones available for mound, pits impractible
