
MAP OF SURVEY SECTION 10, T.8S., R. 44E., W.M. BAKER COUNTY, OREGON

SAID PIPES CONTAIN A MAGNET SO THAT THEY MAY BE DETECTED ELECTRONICALLY. WHERE AVAILABLE, I MARKED BEARING TREES AS SHOWN HEREON, ATTACHED A BRASS WASHER MARKED "LS 1658" NEAR THE BOTTOM OF THE FACE OF EACH BT, PAINTED FACES WITH RED PAINT, SMOOTHED THE BARK AND PAINTED A 6" RED BAND AROUND EACH BT AT APPROXIMATELY 51/2 FOOT HEIGHT AND ATTACHED THE APPROPRIATE U.S.F.S. SIGNS. DISTANCES ARE TAKEN TO THE CENTER OF JUST ABOVE THE ROOT CROWN UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE

NARRATIVE

WITHIN THE SECTION SHOWN HEREON. TO DO SO, ALL EXTERIOR SECTION AND 1/4 SECTION CORNERS WHICH WERE NEEDED FOR CONTROL WERE RECOVERED OR RE-ESTABLISHED AND THE SECTION THEN SUBDIVIDED, SETTING ALL REQUIRED SUBDIVISION CORNERS AND MARKING ALL U.S.F.S. BOUNDARY LINES WITH 6 FOOT STEEL FENCE POSTS AND SIGNS. THE SURVEY WAS CONDUCTED USING A 10" TOPCON THEODOLITE AND A MCHENRY EDM OR A 1" JENA THEODOLITE AND MCHENRY EDM.

REFERENCE MATERIALS USED WERE AS FOLLOWS: 1. GENERAL LAND OFFICE RECORDS. 2. RESTORATIONS OF RECORD BY: THE BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT; THE BAKER COUNTY SURVEYOR; CARL SUNDET, LS# 1664; HARRY HILDEBRAND, LS# 1898; JAMES HAMBLETON, LS# 645 AND THE WALLOWA COUNTY SURVEYOR, VERNE RUSSELL, LS# 427. 3. NONE OF THE FEW RECORD SURVEYS FOUND FOR THIS AREA PROVED TO BE OF ANY USE AS CONTROL FOR THESE SECTIONS, EXCEPT THOSE BY CARL SUNDET IN 1982.

BEARINGS USED HEREON ARE TRUE, BASED UPON A SOLAR OBSERVATION TAKEN APPROXIMATELY 500 FEET EASTERLY OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 10.



THE ORIGINAL GENERAL LAND OFFICE SURVEY OF THE EXTERIOR OF TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 44 EAST W.M. WAS CONDUCTED BY N.O. WALDEN IN 1873 UNDER CONTRACT NUMBER 198. THE INTERIOR OF BOTH TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 44 EAST & TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST WAS ORIGINALLY SURVEYED BY WILLIAM BARR UNDER CONTRACT, NUMBER 388 IN 1881. W. BARR ALSO CLAIMS TO HAVE RETRACED THE EXTERIOR OF TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 44 EAST UNDER THE SAME CONTRACT. MANAGEMENT IN RECENT YEARS. JOHN G. COLLINS DID RETRACEMENT AND MINERAL CLAIM SURVEYS IN SECTIONS 16 & 17 in 1924 PER GLO RECORDS. IRA HOFFMAN DID SURVEYS IN SEVERAL SECTIONS WITHIN THIS TWP., SOME OF WHICH IS RECORDED IN THE GLO RECORDS AND SOME IS CONTAINED IN 36 HANDRITTEN AND UN-INDEXED BOOKS WHICH ARE NOW IN THE POSSESSION OF THE BAKER COUNTY SURVEYOR, JAMES HANLEY, AND WHICH COVER A TIME PERIOD OF FROM 1899 TO 1931. SEVERAL CORNERS IN THIS TWP. HAVE BEEN MONUMENTED BY J. HANLEY, PRESENT COUNTY SURVEYOR AND ARE OF RECORD IN HIS OFFICE. CARL SUNDET RE-TRACED PORTIONS OF THE EAST AND NORTH LINE OF T. 8 S., R.44 W. AND SUBDIVIDED SECTIONS 4 & 6 in 1982-3. A FEW CORNERS IN SAID TWP. HAVE BEEN PERPETUATED BY HARRY C. HILDEBRAND, LS #1896, CIRCA 1982.
