


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Nicolas O. Walden made the original survey under Contract No. 198, dated July 15, 1873. At the section corner location common to sections 31, 32 & 5, 6, T 8 & 9 S, R 45 E, he set a basalt rock 16 x 8 x 8, 8" in ground.

Description of corner evidence found:

At the above mentioned section corner I found a basalt stone 17 x 9 x 8 on the surface in a small mound of stone. No markings were visible on the stone. No other evidence was in area and large rock was limited to corner only.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the section corner location I set a 2" x 30" galv. iron pipe with a brass cap approx. 18" above surface of ground as area is gravelly. I then placed original stone on the north side of the monument and then made a large mound of stone 3½ ft. dia. and 3 ft. high covering the monument and the original stone. There are no accessories available.
