## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

W.B. Barr made the original survey under Contract No. 355, dated June 14, 1880. At the section corner location common to Sections 29, 30, 31 & 32, T 8 S R 45 E, he set a marked basalt rock 14" x 10" x 8".

## Description of corner evidence found:

At the above mentioned section corner location, I found a basalt stone  $14 \times 10 \times 7$  in a mound of stone and being marked with 1 notch on the south face and 5 notches on the east edge.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the section corner location I set a 2" x 30" galv. iron pipe with a brass cap approx. 20" above surface as ground very rocky. Set the original stone along the west edge of the iron pipe in a large mound of stone approx. 4 ft. dia. and 2 ft. high. There was no accessories available.
