
Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 30" long aluminum pipe with $3\frac{1}{4}$ " aluminum cap, marked as shown above, 6" above ground. Steel post with sign 54-9 set next to cap.

16" pine S.22°E. 90.0' "1/4 S1 BT"

Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and nailed aluminum washer stamped "RLS 1928" by "BT scribe on tree. Painted blaze red and a 6" red band around tree.
