## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

MAINTAINED corner position by improving surrounding rock mound and setting steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached and marking the following bearing objects, there being no trees within limits.

A basalt boulder 32" x 38" projecting 18" out of the ground bears  $832^{\circ}$ W,  $36.5^{\circ}$  distant marked "BXO" on its center top, distance taken to "X". Painted boulder red. A basalt boulder 23" x 38" projecting 30" out of the ground bears  $85^{\circ}$ E,  $67.3^{\circ}$  distant marked "BXO" on its center top, distance taken to "X". Painted boulder red.

Compass declination 20° East.
