## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by W.B.Barr under GLO contract no. 358 dated June 14, 1880.

Surveyor General records state:

Marked basalt rock 24 x 24 x 16 for corner 21, 22, 27 & 28. Raised mound of rock as per instructions.

Corner REESTABLISHED by USDI-BLM in 1983 under

Special Instructions dated August 4, 1983 -under-Group
No. 1169, Oregon... The cor of secs 21,22,27 and 28 determined at the intersection of wire fences extending N and E along the line of traces of old down fences, with a basalt stone 21x20x16" (record 24x24x16") no marks discernible, lying alongside the fence corner, position of the original corner. At the corner point...Set an iron post 28'' long  $2\frac{1}{2}''$  diam 15" in the ground to solid rock, in a mound of stone 5' base to top with brass cap marked (as shown in diagram).

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found a  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " dia brass cap on  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe projecting 6" out of ground surrounded with a rock mound. Brass cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

NOTE: A fence corner bears East 1.5' from which the fences run North & East.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Maintained corner monument by improving surrounding rock mound, placing steel fence post 3' South with sign 54-9, and establishing 2 reference mounments as follows, there being no trees or bearing objects available within limits.

Reference mounuments established:


A 5/8" diam rebar 30" long with  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " diam aluminum cap attached and driven 20" to refusal bears N25 $\frac{1}{2}$ E, 9.1' dist marked:

A 5/8" diam rebar 30" long with  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " diam aluminum cap attached and driven 15" to refusal bears S51°E, 7.5' dist marked:

Each rebar reference monument has a steel fence post alongside with signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached.

Compass declination  $20^{\circ}$  East.
