At position midway between adjacent quarter corner East and section corner West as determined by survey...

Set 2½" aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 25" in ground with 5" projecting out of ground with surrounding rock mound and 6' fence post alongside with sign 54-9 & 54-2 attached. Cap marked as shown in diagram.

New bearing trees established:

Ponderosa pine 13" dia brs S14°W, 87.8' dist marked 1/4S12 BT.

A poplar 8" dia brs N68°E, 21.1' dist marked 1/4S1 BT (bark scribe).

Each BT has a sign 54-3 and signs 54-4 or 54-9 attached below a 6" band of red paint, and each new BT has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.

Compass declination 19° East.
