Plan of the Original Townsite of Halfway.


Map of Black and Motley's Addition, 1916.

Statement by D. W. C. Nelson is attached to the above Black and Motley Addition Map in which he found the South line of Section 8 to be short 107 feet of the distance shown on the above plat by Ira Huffman. 1934. See Record of Town Plats, page 19, Courthouse.

Philo H. Anderson maps of surveys of 1937, 1948 and 1958. See Land Title Insurance Agency files, No. 12, Outside.

These maps show considerable differences in distances along the South line of Section 8 and the centerline of Record Street, and it is not possible to justify this wide divergence, except by the explanation of careless workmanship in the early surveys, and the various erroneous corner relocations of impermanent corner locations.

The permanent monumentation of this survey is the basis for establishment of positive control for the City of Halfway, and it will be in the City's interest to require filing of a copy of plats of any subsequent surveys performed within the city limits with the city officials, such filing to be in addition to Oregon Revised Statutes requirements of filing with county surveyor.
