

This survey for John Binford in Halfway, Oregon, was made for the purpose of providing descriptions of the three parcels shown, preliminary to preparation of a land partition plat. The westerly monument of two at the intersection of Record and Main Streets (North) and the monument marking the South quarter corner of Section 8, T. 8S., R. 46E., W.M. is basis of bearing for Record Street = S. 89° 48' 48"W. and yields the bearing N. 22° 40' 40"W. for Main Street P.I. UNCAPPED centerline. The parcels to be surveyed for descriptions were identified by John Binford. Angle point in the Baker — Cornucopia Highway centerline was determined by intersection point based on sidewalk culture on Westerly side of highway, 30 feet distance and parallel to, for that part shown bearing N. 52° 46' 25" W. Reference Surveys 8-46-20, 8-46-24, 8-46-35, and 8-46-42 contain relevant data concerning highway (Main Street) centerlines.
