

NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF TERRY VAUGHAN, WITH THE PURPOSE OF SURVEYING A PROPOSED PROPERTY LINE ADJUSTMENT. THE SUBJECT PROPERTIES ARE DESCRIBED ON BAKER COUNTY DEED NO.'S 97 20 174 AND B10 41 0098.

A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE AVAILABLE RECORDS PERTAINING TO THIS SURVEY. THE MAP OF COFFINBERRY ADDITION TO HALFWAY WAS PREPARED BY C.W. BLAKESLEE, DATED MARCH 30, 1918. A SEARCH OF THE BAKER COUNTY SURVEYOR'S RECORDS PRODUCED SURVEY NO.'S 8-46-20, 8-46-31, 8-46-33, 8-46-58, 8-46-79 THROUGH 8-46-89 AND 8-46-108.

FIELD MEASUREMENTS WERE MADE TO RECOVER CONTROLLING MONUMENTS, ALL OF WHICH WERE ACCEPTED, AS SHOWN HEREON.

I SEARCHED FOR POSSIBLE UNRECORDED MONUMENTATION AT THE CORNERS OF THE LOTS WITHIN COFFINBERRY ADDITION ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF COMMERCIAL STREET, BUT FOUND NOTHING. ALL OF THE NECESSARY MONUMENTS FROM SURVEY NO. 8-46-58 ALONG THE NORTHERLY BOUNDARY OF MR. VAUGHAN'S PROPERTY WERE RECOVERED, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ONE. THAT CORNER POSITION WAS CALCULATED BY DISTANCE-DISTANCE INTERSECTION MEASURED FROM THE NEAREST FOUND PINS FROM SURVEY NO.'S 8-46-31 AND 8-46-58.

TO PLACE COFFINBERRY ADDITION, I HELD THE FOUND MONUMENTS ALONG THE CENTERLINES OF COMMERCIAL STREET AND GOVER LANE TO DETERMINE THE RIGHT OF WAY LINES OF THOSE STREETS. THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF COFFINBERRY ADDITION WAS THEN DETERMINED AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE NORTH RIGHT OF WAY LINE OF COMMERCIAL STREET WITH THE NORTHERLY PROJECTION OF THE WEST LINE OF GOVER LANE. THIS LOCATION FIT THE SIDEWALK ALONG THE EAST LINE OF THE ADDITION. FROM THIS POINT, I MEASURED THE PLAT DISTANCE OF 383 FEET WEST ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF COMMERCIAL STREET TO DETERMINE THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE ADDITION.

NEW MONUMENTS WERE SET FOR THE PROPERTY LINE ADJUSTMENT AT LOCATIONS APPROVED BY MR. VAUGHAN, AND ACCORDING TO THE EVIDENCE FOUND AND METHODS DESCRIBED HEREIN.
