History of original corner establishment:

Surveyors General's notes state: "Set basalt stone 24 X 12 X 4 ins. 15 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 13, 14, 23 & 24, marked 3 notches S and 1 notch E edges from which A Pine 18 ins. in diam. bears N50°E, 30 lks. dist. marked T9SR36ES13 BT. A Fir 8 ins. diam. bears S40°E, 18 lks. dist. marked

Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of corner stone. Corner falls on a steep hill-side that has been logged. Found 18" White Fir with grown over blazes and barely visible BT. From which measured N44°W, 12.0 ft., from which a rotton stump, no scribing, bears N55°E, 20.4 ft. and a rotton stump, no scribing, bears N77°W, 43.1 ft. No trace of SW BT.

Corner is about 200 ft. North of road at drain crossing.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

A 12" Fir bears N19°W, 24.0 ft. scribed T9SR36ES14 BT. Placed 54-3s and brass washer stamped PLS 1051 on the BTs. Old BT has 54-3. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' West of corner.
