
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. R-23

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by William R. Gradon under G.L.O. contract No. 409, from May 26- June 26, 1882. Surveyor General's notes state "Set post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. from which: A Fir 18" in diameter bears N85°E, 25 lks. marked 1/4S BT. A Fir 10 ins in diameter bears N55°W, 20 lks. dist. marked 1/4S BT."



## Description of corner evidence found:

Found 20" white for stump, cut part has faint "1/45" scribing. Measured S15°W, 16.5 ft. from which a down 10" white fir, scribed "1/45", stump hole of which bears S50°W, 17.8 ft. Probed and found hole from old wood at corner point. No other trace of wood post found.

Corner falls about 200' above track road, above Sumpter Highway.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At above described point set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 25" in the ground and placed a few rocks around. From which by magnetic declination of N20°E: A 16" Tamarac bears S30°W, 44.5 ft. scribed 1/4 S25 BT. A 12" Tamarac bears N22°W, 65.6 ft. scribed 1/4S24 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band

around. Placed 54-3s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-4 on steel fence post 5' East of the corner.
