At the corner I found a 16"x10"x6" stone lying on the ground marked  $\frac{1}{4}$ . At S80 E 13.2 ft is a down and rotting 10" lodgepole pine marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S BT The other BT is completely gone

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

After checking the position of the original stone from the remaining BT I set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x32" aluminum capped aluminum pipe 28" in the ground in a mound of stone from which

A 6" White Fir bears S25 W 47.68 ft marked & S 34BT nail in E base

A 10" Lodgepole pine bears N37 E 14.81 ft marked \\$S35BT nail in W base

Bearings taken with a staff compass declination  $18\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  East per 1980 Isogonic chart

Distance pulled to 60d nail with Brass washer stamped LS 1898 driven in the side center of the bearing trees.
