Description of corner evidence found:

At the corner loaction I found no evidence of the original stone. The corner falls on a very steep slope and it might have rolled down the hill, 18" Fir stump and remains of rotted tree bears N80 $^{\circ}$ W 30.4 ft marked ½ S BT.

There is no remaining evidence of the Alder tree

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

From the remaining BT I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x32" Brass capped steel pipe 6" in the ground in a large mound of stone from which:
A 6" White Fir bears N88 W 14.82 ft mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ S 33 BT nail in S base
A 6" White Fir bears S80 E 56. 74 ft mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 BT nail in S base

Bearings taken with staff compass declination 18½ East per 1980 Isogonic chart.

Distances pulled to 60d nail with Brass washer stamped LS 1898 driven in the side center of the bearing trees
